### Election Day is Tuesday, November 7, 2006

**Polls are open 6 a.m. – 9 p.m.**

**Remember – you must be registered to vote!**

- Last day to register by mail for the general election:  
Postmark by October 13, received by October 18;
- Last day to register in person: October 13;
- In-person registration for people honorably discharged from the military or who become naturalized citizens after October 13: October 27;
- Last day to apply for an absentee ballot by mail: Postmarked by October 31;
- Last day to apply in person for an absentee ballot: November 6;
- Last day to postmark absentee ballot: November 6. Date it must be received by Board of Elections: November 14;
- Last day to deliver an absentee ballot in person to the County Board of Elections: November 7.
